### **Academic Planning Framework - an invitation**

Recently, the UPEI Senate established a committee to develop an Academic Planning Framework for the university. The membership of the committee provides for two (2) representatives of the Faculty Association.

Chaired by the VP-Academic Development, the committee is charged with developing an overall planning process that will address the following:

- to support teaching and learning success
- to develop an academic planning process
- to utilize students interest, and market demands to assist in identifying potential programs
- to develop a strategy which links academic planning to space, budget and infrastructure planning
- to support student recruitment and enrollment planning
- to reflect upon the role and direction of on-line learning

The report of this committee will have a profound influence on academic planning at UPEI. It is vital that the Faculty Association be represented by people with a strong belief in the academic future of UPEI, and commitment to the interests of faculty and academic staff in that future.

The tentative plan is to have the committee begin work as soon as possible, with an eye to having a report for presentation to Senate by the end of the current academic year.
